

PRELIMINARY LEGISLATION – Village Consent

The following Resolution enacted by the Village of Ansonia, Darke County, Ohio, hereinafter referred to as the Local Public Agency (LPA), in the matter of the stated described project.

SECTION I - Project Description

WHEREAS, the STATE has identified the need for the described project:

The project will remove existing deteriorated sidewalk and construct new sidewalk crossing improvements including ADA curb ramps at the north side of East Canal Street (SR47) from Main Street (SR 118) to 50' east of the high school drive. Install a Rectangular Rapid Flashing Beacon at the crossing with the Mobile Home Park Drive. A fence will also be installed along the south side of East Canal Street (SR 47) fronting the Mobile Home Park. This project is further identified as DAR-SRTS-Ansonia IFS 1.

NOW THEREFORE, be it ordained by the Village of Ansonia, Ohio.

SECTION II - Consent Statement

Being in the public interest, the LPA gives consent to the Director of Transportation to complete the above described project.

SECTION III - Cooperation Statement

The LPA shall cooperate with the Director of Transportation in the above described project as follows:

The LPA has no obligation for costs for the project as described in Section I. ODOT will provide all Federal-aid and State funds as set aside by the Director of Transportation for the financing of this improvement from funds allocated by the Federal Highway Administration, U.S. Department of Transportation.

In addition, the LPA also agrees pay One-Hundred Percent (100%) of the cost of those features requested by the LPA which are determined by the State and Federal Highway Administration to be unnecessary for the Project.

The LPA further agrees to pay One-Hundred Percent (100%) of the cost to install and/or repair

curb ramps (if applicable) at all necessary intersections to ensure compliance with the Americans with Disabilities Act.

SECTION IV - Utilities and Right-of-Way Statement

The LPA agrees that all right-of-way (if applicable) required for the described project will be acquired and/or made available in accordance with current State and Federal regulations. The LPA also understands that right-of-way costs include eligible utility costs.

The LPA agrees that all utility accommodation, relocation and reimbursement will comply with the current provisions of 23 CFR 645 and the ODOT Utilities Manual.

SECTION V – Maintenance

Upon completion of the Project, and unless otherwise agreed, the LPA shall: (1) provide adequate maintenance for the Project in accordance with all applicable state and federal law, including, but not limited to, Title 23, U.S.C. Section 116; (2) provide ample financial provisions, as necessary, for such maintenance of the Project; (3) maintain the right-of-way, keeping it free of obstructions; and, (4) hold said right-of-way inviolate for public highway purposes.

SECTION VI - Authority to Sign

The Village Administrator of said Village of Ansonia is hereby empowered on

behalf of the Village of Ansonia to enter into contracts with the Director of Transportation necessary to complete the above described project.
