**A RESOLUTION TO PROCEED WITH SUBMISSION OF THE QUESTION OF  
LEVYING A(N) 3.0 MILL IN EXCESS OF THE TEN-MILL LIMITATION FOR  
THE PURPOSE OF CURRENT EXPENSES FOR THE VILLAGE OF ANSONIA,  
OHIO AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.**

The Council for the Village of Ansonia, Darke County, Ohio (Council) met in session on June 1, 2021 with the following members present:

Christa Everman Moved the adoption of the following resolution:

**PREAMBLE**

**WHEREAS**, the Council approved the following resolution declaring the necessity to levy a tax in excess of the ten-mill limitation:

Resolution No: 5 -2021.

Date Approved: May 18, 2021.

; and,

**WHEREAS**, the Darke County Auditor ("Auditor") has certified the following information to the Council:

1. The total current tax valuation of the Village of Ansonia is as follows: \$ 13,582,550.
2. The number of mills required to generate a specified amount of revenue is, or:
3. The dollar amount of revenue that would be generated by a specified number of mills is:
  - Specified number of mills: 3.0
  - Dollar amount of revenue generated: \$ 34,910.
  - This rate amounts to the following for each one hundred dollars of tax valuation:  
\$ 0.30 for each one hundred dollars of valuation.

## RESOLUTION

**NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESLOVED**, by the Council, at least two-thirds (2/3) of all of the members of the council concurring, as follows:

1. The Council shall proceed with the submission of the question of the tax electors.
2. The rate of the tax levy, expressed in mills for each one dollar in tax valuation as estimated by the Auditor, is as follows:
  - a. 3.0 Mills
  - b. This rate amounts to the following for each one hundred dollars in tax valuation;  
\$ 0.30 for each one hundred dollars of valuation
  - c. If the levy is a renewal levy or a replacement levy, this rate is the same as the existing tax levy.
3. Pursuant to R. C. § 5705.03(B)(1):
  - a. The purpose of the tax is as follows: To provide additional funds for the current expenses of the Village of Ansonia.
  - b. The type of levy is as follows: It is a renewal levy with 0 increase and 0 decrease.
  - c. The Sections of the Revised Code authorizing submission of the question of the tax are R.C. §§ 5705.03, 5705.191, and 5705.25 and 5705.19(A);
  - d. The term of the tax is as follows in duplicate years: 2022,2023,2024,2025, and 2026.
  - e. The Territory where the tax is to be levied ia as follows: Upon the entire Village of Ansonia Corporation.
  - f. The date of the election at which the question of the tax shall appear on the ballot is as follows: November 2, 2021.
  - g. The territory where the ballot measure is to be submitted is as follows: Upon the entire Village of Ansonia Corporation.
  - h. The tax will be first levied and collected as follows:
    - i. The tax year in which the tax will first be levied is 2022.
    - ii. The calendar year in which the tax will first be collected is 2023.
  - i. The Village of Ansonia only has territory in Darke County.
4. The Fiscal Officer is hereby directed to **certify the levy to the Auditor AND the Board of Elections, Darke County, Ohio (“BOE”)**. Certification shall include copies of ALL of the following documents:

- a. **Resolution of Necessity** (Resolution No. 5-2021 adapted on May 18, 2021); and,
- b. **Certification of the Auditor**; and,
- c. **Resolution to Proceed.**

Certification shall occur by **no later than 4:00 PM on August 2, 2021.**

The Fiscal Officer shall also notify the BOE to cause notice of the Election on the question of levying the tax to be given as required by law.

- 5. All formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the passage of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of the council, and all deliberations of this council and of its committees that resulted in such formal action were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements, including R.C. § 121.22.
- 6. This Resolution is deemed to be an emergency measure necessary for the health, welfare, and safety of the Village of Ansonia, Ohio. This Resolution shall be in full force and effect immediately upon adoption.

Steve Hildebrand seconded the motion.



### Certificate of Estimated Property Tax Revenue

Use this form when a taxing authority certifies a millage rate  
And requests the revenue produced by that rate.

The county auditor of Darke County, Ohio, does hereby certify the following:

1. On May 20, 2021, the taxing authority of the Village of Ansonia certified a copy of its resolution or ordinance adopted May 18, 2021, requesting the county auditor to certify the current tax valuation of the subdivision and the amount of revenue that would be produced by three (3.00) mills, to levy a tax outside the 10-mill limitation for purposes pursuant to Revised Code § 5705.19(A), to be placed on the ballot at the November 2, 2021 election. The levy type is Renewal for a 5 year for Current Expense.
2. The estimated property tax revenue that will be produced by the stated millage, assuming the tax valuation of the subdivision remains constant throughout the life of the levy, is calculated to be \$34,910.
3. The total tax valuation of the subdivision used in calculating the estimated property tax revenue is \$13,582,550.
4. This levy is  Including the entire territory of the Village.
5. At a rate not to exceed 3.00 mills for each dollar of valuation, which amounts to \$.30 for each one hundred dollars of valuation.
6. The levy will be applied to the 2022 Tax Duplicate Year with collection starting in year 2023.

#### Instructions

1. "Total tax valuation" includes the taxable value of all real property in the subdivision as indicated on the tax list most recently certified for collection and estimates of the taxable value of personal and public utility personal property for the first year the levy will be collected as set forth on the worksheets prescribed in conjunction with this form. If the subdivision is located in more than one county, the home county auditor (where the greatest taxable value of the subdivision is located) shall obtain the assistance of the other county auditors to establish the total tax valuation of the subdivision.
2. For purposes of this certification, "subdivision" includes any agency, board, commission or other authority authorized to request a taxing authority to submit a tax levy on its behalf.
3. "Levy type" includes the following: (1) additional, (2) renewal, (3) renewal with an increase, (4) renewal with a decrease, (5) replacement, (6) replacement with an increase and (7) replacement with a decrease levies.
4. List of Villages/City included/excluded in the levy issue.
5. Example - 1 mill equals \$.10 per \$100 of valuation.
6. Please file this certificate with the subdivision as soon as possible, so the taxing authority can pass a resolution to proceed not later than 90 days before the election.
