FINANCE DIRECTOR: May Tax and Finance Report given to Council to review. Motion by Everman, 2nd by Hackler to approve both reports. All yea.

POLICE: Chief Shapiro would like assistance in looking into getting grants for the police department to assist in expenses.

FIRE: Chief Widener gave update on runs. Have some teens interested in joining the Cadet Program if Village restarts. Chief will update any policy needed to start the program up again.

MAYORS REPORTS: None

COMMITTEE: Safety committee met with Chief Shapiro to discuss grant options; recruiting efforts; resource officer; research into getting body and dash cams; wages; among other things.

VILLAGE ADMINISTRATOR:

1. Update given on Sanitary Sewer Project
2. Not heard anything concerning natural gas contract
3. Still Working on setting up training with Jaime Campbell for generator
4. Hoping to receive second round of American Rescue Plan money in June.
5. Met with cemetery board to discuss rates. Tom to prepare Ordinance with new rates and present at next meeting.
6. Need stop signs at end of West High (both ends).
7. Darke County Health Department will be paying for 3 mosquito sprayings.
8. CDBG went out for bid (sewer lining).
9. Brown Twp would like to put water back to barn. Council agreed that they would only charge 50% for tap in fee (\$250).
10. Water Leak by Vet Supply has been fixed.

Councilman Gariety: Park Net needs fixed asap. Questioned where we are at with barn. Tent and temporary electric for 4th of July will be coming on Thursday prior to event.

Some properties in town need to be mowed.

Dan Turners place needs cleaned up. Tom to send him a certified letter.

CSX is dumping railroad gravel all over Jackson and tearing up yards and roads.

Stop sign on Cross Street needs cleaned off.

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
NEW/OLD BUSINESS:

At 7:15 the meeting was opened for Public Hearing on 2023 Budget. Budget discusses; no questions. Public Hearing closed and returned to regular meeting.



Motion by Gariety, 2nd by Everman to pass the Emergency Clause. All yea.
2. Ordinance No. 3-2022 – An Ordinance designating the zone from the east property lone of 120 E Canal St West to the intersection of Main Street (north side) as a not truck parking zone and placing signs as such and declaring an emergency. Motion by Brown, 2nd by Everman to suspend the rules and read the Ordinance one time by title only. All yea. Motion by Middleton, 2nd by Gariety to pass the Ordinance. All yea. Motion by Brown, 2nd by Hildebrand to pass the Emergency Clause. All yea.
