4. Sanitary Sewer Project update given
5. Sprayed for mosquitos on July 27. Scheduled to spray again for 08/18 and 08/32.
6. Generator up and running. Still working on pump 1 issue.
7. Will be receiving \$4000 for park grant.
8. Greg Byrd is aware of the issue at 211 Riffle and is working on it.
9. Will be sweeping streets one more time before end of year

Councilman comments: Trees at trailer park by DG need trimmed. Hanging over sidewalk.; Need to start looking at re-surfacing some of our streets in town; Eric Beisners property needs mowed; Park net still issue needs taken care of; need to look into getting water tower repainted; catch basins need cleaned; weeks growing in streets and sidewalks around town need sprayed; need updated contact information.
