

ORDINANCE NO. 2-2025

AN ORDINANCE APPROVING, ADOPTING AND ENACTING THE 2025 EDITION OF THE OHIO BASIC CODE, 2025 EDITION, AS THE CODE OF ORDINANCES FOR THE VILLAGE OF ANSONIA, OHIO; AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, the Village needs a codification of such legislation, with which to administer the affairs of the Village, ensure law and order and avoid practical and legal entanglements; and

WHEREAS, Article XVIII, Section 3, of the Ohio Constitution requires that Village law be in conformity with State law in those areas specified therein;

NOW, THEREFORE, be it ordained by the Council of the Village Ansonia, Ohio, that:

SECTION ONE

The 2025 Edition of the Ohio Basic Code, as published by American Legal Publishing Corporation, is hereby approved, adopted, and enacted by and for the Village. Any prior version of the Ohio Basic Code which may have been previously adopted by the municipality is hereby repealed as obsolete and is hereby replaces in its entirety by this Ohio Basic Code, 2025 Edition

SECTION TWO

One book-form copy of the 2025 Edition the Ohio Basic Code shall be attached to this ordinance as a part hereof and filed with the permanent ordinance records of the Village.

SECTION THREE

All ordinances and resolutions or parts thereof which are in conflict or inconsistent with any provision of the 2025 Edition of the Ohio Basic Code, as adopted in Section I hereof, are hereby repealed as of the effective date of this ordinance, except as follows:

A. The enactment of the 2025 Edition of the Basic Ohio Code shall not be construed to affect a right or liability accrued or incurred under any legislative provision prior to the effective date of such enactment, or an action or proceeding for the enforcement of such right or liability. Such enactment shall not be construed to relieve any person from punishment for an act committed in violation of any such legislative provision, nor to affect an indictment or prosecution therefor. For such purposes, any such legislative provision shall continue in full force notwithstanding its repeal for the purpose of revision and codification.

B. The repeal provided above shall not affect:

- (1) The grant or creation of a franchise, license, right, easement or privilege;
- (2) The purchase, sale, lease, or transfer of property;
- (3) The appropriation or expenditure of money or promise or guarantee of payment;
- (4) The assumption of any contract or obligation;
- (5) The issuance and delivery of any bonds, obligations, or other instruments of indebtedness;
- (6) The levy or imposition of taxes, assessments, or charges;
- (7) The establishment, naming, vacating or grade level of any street or public way;

- (8) The dedication of property or plat approval;
- (9) The annexation or detachment of territory;
- (10) Any legislation enacted subsequent to the adoption of this ordinance.

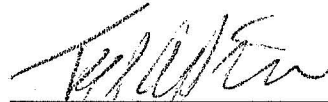
SECTION FOUR

Pursuant to Ohio R.C. 731.21, 731.22 and 731.23, the Clerk of Council shall cause to be published a notice of the enactment of this ordinance, containing the title of the ordinance.

SECTION FIVE

This ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure, immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety, such emergency existing by reason of the necessity of providing a Municipal Code that is consistent with the latest State law, as required by the Ohio Constitution, and this ordinance, including the 2025 Edition of the Ohio Basic Code adopted hereby, shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its passage by at least two-thirds of all members elected to Council, otherwise from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
